Stage 1

5 Juz

The "5 Juz" category is for competitors up to the age of 23

15 Juz

The "15 Juz" category is for competitors up to the age of 28

Recitation

The recitation category is for competitors up to the age of 18

FAQ

How is the competition organized and structured?

The Quran Competition will consist of three rounds, designed to showcase the talents of participants across different age categories. The first round will be a private audition phase, followed by a (streamed) digital competition, and culminating in the grand finale event on February 15.

Who can participate?

This event is open for scandinavian males up to the age of 35. Note that the different categories have different age limits.

Does the Quran competition require me to know the 15 or 5 juz in a specific order?

No, the Quran competition does not require you to know the 15 or 5 Juz in a specific order. It doesn't matter which Ajzaa you have memorized, as long as the total memorized amount adds up to 15 or 5 Juz.

Is travel, lodging and food covered?

Meals will be provided, and details on food and lodging will be shared with relevant participants.

What criteria do the judges judge by?
